STATE AND FEDERAL CONTRACTS

Arkansas Army National Guard (AR ARNG) has implemented and is maintaining an environmental Management System (eMS), in accordance with Executive Orders (EO) 13423 and 13514 to guide its operation in an environmentally sound manner while maintaining and enhancing readiness. AR ARNG is and will continue to be a leader in protecting the environment. The Contractor shall perform work under contract consistent with the relevant policy and objectives identified in the AR ARNG eMS. Contractors shall refer to the Arkansas National Guard public website (located at <http://www.arguard.org/enviro.html>) to read and understand the environmental policy statement.

In addition, the Contractor shall ensure that its employees and subcontractors are aware of the roles and responsibilities identified by the eMS and how these requirements affect the work performed under this contract. If the actions, services, and/or supplies have the potential to cause negative environmental impacts, the Contractor is responsible for development and implementation of steps to prevent the potential negative impact. In the event an environmental non-conformance or non-compliance associated with the contract is identified, the Contractor is responsible for taking corrective action immediately. Contractors are liable for any enforcement actions, fines, and/or penalties resulting from their failure to comply with applicable federal, state, local, and Army regulations.
