SUBJECT: Army National Guard (ARNG) Title 10 One Time Occasional Tour (OTOT) Announcement for Joint Task Force Civil Support (JTF-CS), Joint Base Langley-Eustis, VA

1. References:

a. AR 135-18, The Active Guard Reserve (AGR) Program, 1 November 2004.

b. Memorandum, National Guard Bureau, ARNG-HRH, 12 December 2013, subject: Title 10 Army National Guard Active Guard Reserve Life Cycle Management Strategy and Plan (ARNG-HRH Policy Memorandum #13-041).

2. The ARNG is seeking applications from highly qualified officers to serve as J3, Director for Joint Operations, Training, Readiness and Exercises for JTF-CS at Joint Base Langley-Eustis, VA. **This announcement may close early if a suitable candidate is selected prior to the suspense date.**

3. Eligibility. Current T10/T32 Active Guard Reserve (AGR) Officers, as well as traditional ARNG Officers.

4. The selected officer will be processed the following way depending on their current duty status.

a. T10 AGR officer – will remain in the T10 AGR program and will receive Permanent Change in Station (PCS) orders.

b. T32 AGR officer- will be accessed into the T10 AGR program for duration of two years on a One Time Occasional Tour (OTOT). Upon completion of the tour, the officer will be separated from the T10 AGR program and returned to the T32 AGR program.

c. T32 Traditional officer- will be accessed into the T10 AGR program for duration of two years on a One Time Occasional Tour (OTOT). Upon completion of the tour, the officer will be separated from the T10 AGR program.

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5. Brief Duty Description: J3, Director for Joint Operations, Training, Readiness and Exercises for Joint Task Force Civil Support (JTF-CS), the SECDEF's only standing operational JTF responsible for planning and executing a national level Chemical, Biological, Radiological, or Nuclear Explosives (CBRNE) Consequence Management (CM) or DSCA response. Establishes requirements for and conducts Joint exercises to maintain operational readiness for the JTF-CS HQ and Defense CBRNE Response Force (DCRF) comprised of 4 TFs with over 5200 personnel. Works specifically with USARNORTH/JFLCC, USNORTHCOM, and Service components J3s/Staffs. Coordinates with DHS, FEMA, HHS, CDC, and other associated IA/Mission partners. Key billet for DCRF deployment and joint execution of contingency plans. Prepares, coordinates, and publishes the Command's Joint Training Plan (JTP) and Exercise plan.

6. Pre-requisites:

a. Applicants must meet AGR eligibility requirements IAW AR 135-18

b. Grade: O6 (**exceptionally strong operations background at Brigade level minimum, G-3 experience at Division level optimal. Prior MTOE brigade command highly desired**)

c. Branch Requirement: 02A

d. Civilian Education: Commensurate with requirements of grade

e. Military Education: DCSA Phase I complete prior to reporting. DCSA Phase II within 30-60 days of arrival. JPME Phase II and Senior Service College complete highly desired.

f. Assignment History: Prior DSCA, CBRNE and joint service highly desired but not a requisite for applying.

g. Security Clearance: Must have a current Top Secret (SCI) security clearance at the time of application

7. Application.

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packets must be in accordance with the enclosed application process and be received no later than 31 October 2014.

b. Applications received with postage funded by the US Government for "personal" mail will be destroyed. Applications received with (TAG, MILPO, etc.) endorsements are authorized US Government funded postage. Use of US Government funded overnight or express mail is not authorized.

c. Applicants currently serving in T10 AGR status should submit a DA 4187 to the COL assignments officer in paragraph 8 below NLT COB 31 October 2014.

d. This announcement will close at 1700 EST on 31 October 2014. Packets received after this time or packets that are not complete IAW the T10 AGR officer application checklist will be returned without action. **This announcement may close early if a suitable candidate is selected prior to the suspense date.**
